We have identified that the Year 3 and Year 2 students will need some extra training in typing on a computer and using a mouse and I would encourage parents of these students to make sure that they have the opportunity to do so on home computers if possible as well.

OLNA Testing - Year 10 students will be working on the online OLNA testing over the coming weeks if they have not already demonstrated competency in literacy and numeracy. All students need to be assessed as having adequate literacy and numeracy skills by Year 12.
