Attendance

Attendance at school is a legal requirement for all children from Pre-Primary onwards but more importantly the need to value education and attend school to learn and aspire to success in life is a value we wish all children to have. Together we have a moral purpose to see children are supported, prepared and feel safe to engage at school. Sometimes we don't realise the impact missing school has on children's progress until we start to do the sums:

- Students whose attendance is at 80% - This equals one day per week or two days per fortnight, one year in primary school two years by Year 10
- Non-attendance becomes a life-long habit (unless something big changes).
