Naplan

Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 will be starting NAPLAN testing on Tuesday 15th May. The Year 3 Writing will involve the use of pen and paper but all other tests will take place online with students using a computer to complete them. Each student will sit four tests in Writing, Reading, Language Conventions (spelling and grammar) and Numeracy over a two week period. Parents will receive a printed sheet showing their child's achievement in the testing later in the year.
